# **Fundraising Event Guide for Businesses**

# **Supporting Warrington Youth Zone**

Thank you for considering hosting a fundraising event in support of Warrington Youth **Zone**. Your efforts help us provide vital opportunities and support for young people across our community. To ensure your event is successful and impactful, please follow the guidelines below.



#### 1. Set Clear Goals

- **Target Amount**: Set yourself a fundraising goal. Due to limited resources, Warrington Youth Zone can only provide support for events aiming to raise a minimum amount of £500.00
- **Purpose**: Clearly communicate to attendees what their donations will help achieve (every £1 raised equals a hot meal for a young person). The fundraising team can provide you with assets to use.



#### **2. Plan Well in Advance**

- Choose a Date Early: Avoid clashes with local events or holidays.
- Book Venues/Resources: Secure your location, equipment, and supplies ahead of time.

#### **■ 3. Promote Your Event**

- **Posters**: Display in your workplace, local shops, and community spaces.
- **Social Media**: Share regular updates on your business platforms, tag @WarringtonYouthZone, and use local community groups.
- **Email/Newsletter**: Include event info in internal communications or newsletters.

### 4. Encourage Participation

- **Pre-Registration**: Use sign-up sheets or online forms to confirm numbers in advance (important for catering or logistics).
- **Team Sign-Ups**: For events like quizzes or sports days, encourage early team registrations.

### **□** 5. Choose the Right Type of Event

Here are a few ideas that work well:

- Bake Sale Set up a stall in the office or local venue.
- **Quiz Night** Use a local pub or your office canteen.
- **Tombola or Raffle** Ask local businesses for prize donations.
- **Dress Down Day** -£1 donation for casual wear.
- Sports Day/Challenge Sponsored runs, team games, or fitness challenges.

## **110** 6. Explore Match Funding

- Ask your employer or business contacts if they offer match funding. Many companies will match the amount raised, doubling your impact!
- Let us know if match funding is available so we can help you maximise it.

- Order or gather all necessary materials (e.g., raffle tickets, tablecloths, decorations, prizes) well ahead of the event.
